












Organisation Chart


Tánaiste Launches Ireland's most powerful Supercomputer

The Tánaiste and Minister for Enterprise Trade & Employment, Mary Coughlan TD, formally launched the IBM BlueGene/P Supercomputer - Ireland's most powerful computer, with Larry Hirst (Chairman, IBM EMEA), Prof. Luke Drury (DIAS) and Mike Norris (HEAnet) at a cermony in the Royal Irish Academy, Dublin, October 2008




National Wireless Strategy

 93% have opted for 12 month contract, at €13 per month




HEAnet Schools Broadband Network










Project beginnings and funding

- Government (Forfas) report evaluated success and further research infrastructure needs
- National Development Plan



- Application for funding of mini-grants for IdP's and SP's approved (but paused)
- Other revenue streams under consideration.



Federation Purpose



Foster collaboration



- Enable shared services.
- Enable SaaS
- Supplement GRID/HPC
- Validate student identity (e-commerce)
- Alternative to Athens AM

Federation Members

- IdP's
 - Any entity within Ireland with a <u>student body</u>

- SP's...
 - Any entity providing services to institutions
 - Any entity providing services to <u>students</u>

IdP's

Open to primary/second level <u>schools</u> (single IdP)

• SP's...

- Commercial entities offering a 'student discount'
- GRID to supplement existing authorisation
- HPC hosted applications can authenticate users without knowing the users passwords

Schools

- A single directory holds all student accounts for primary and secondary schools
 - This makes it easy to exclude adults from school services.
 - And exclude school children from third level services
- Releasing a students personal information not possible for those under the age of consent

Student discount

- It is currently impossible to give an online discount to students without paperwork.
- IdP's could charge commercial operators for each identity validated.
- Or the federation could have a higher entry fee for such commercial operators.

(This is one of the revenue streams under consideration)



Federation Protocol

- Initially...
 - SAML1/SAML2/ADFS/Shibb1.3 and 2.0
- Now
 - SAML2 with specific binding/protocol
 - Interoperability between SAML implementations...
 - …allowing commercial SAML products…
 - …alongside open-source











Federation Protocol

Why SAML2?

- Industry converging on SAML2
- Benefits of SAML2 <u>could not</u> be utilised while older/proprietary protocols were excluded
- We expect SAML2 to be the dominant protocol by the time interoperability becomes an issue.
- ADFS 'moving' to SAML2 (let's see Microsoft Geneva...).



Options for IdP's

- Self-managed IdP
 - No fee (for HEA funded institutions)
 - Small fee (for non HEA-funded)

- Managed or Hosted IdP.
 - Additional fee
 - Shibboleth 2.x

Self-managed SP

- No fee for HEA funded institutions
- Membership fee for non HEA-funded

Managed or Hosted SP.


- Additional fee
- Shibboleth 2.x and simpleSAMLphp

- User consent recommended
- Local and embedded WAYF permitted
- Hourly metadata updates.
- Wizards

Shibboleth and simpleSAMLphp Wizards

- Configuration can be difficult for those new to these SAML implementations.
- Wizard interface is designed to make configuration easier for administrators.
- Wizard outputs downloadable configuration files
- The wizards are based on SWITCH RR*


Expected Outcomes

- Policy

- Agreed Membership criteria
- Agreed model to steer the federation in the future
- Agreed production launch date.

Inter-federation



- Attribute schema based on <u>UK Federation</u> Schema to ease bilateral federation.
- UK Federation will be ready for SAML2 in the future





Inter-federation

Multilaterally

- As number of Bilateral agreements grow an inter-federation agreement will emerge.
- Technical solution may be based on SAML2 metadata mergers where possible
- eduGAIN where not possible
- IDEM and Edugate?
